

Until then, I'm looking forward to strollin' through summer, strollin' through the neighborhood, strollin' into stores near you ... I think you get the picture!





DRY EYES AND SCLERAL CONTACT LENSES



Dry Eye Syndrome (DES) is a very common condition that affects people of all ages and ethnicities. DES is considered a multifactorial condition, meaning that there are multiple causes of the dryness. While some of the common causes of DES are using electronic devices and changes in the seasons, it can also be caused by underlying health conditions, such as autoimmune disorders. For some, dry eyes can be chronic, causing problems with irritation, itchy eyes, or blurred vision. When your standard over-the-counter drop does not give enough relief to some of these symptoms, scleral contact lenses could be a great option to help.

Scleral contact lenses are hard lenses made from a special type of plastic. They are different from the standard rigid gas permeable (RGP), or rather hard contact, in that they rest on the sclera (white part of the eye) rather than the cornea (front surface of the eye) like most other types of contact lenses. Since sclerals rest on the white of the eye, they are slightly larger than the average soft contact lense. However, this helps with the comfort of the lenses due to there being less sensitivity on the sclera. The lens is

dome-shaped like a bowl and is filled with a saline solution that creates a liquid reservoir for the cornea. The lens is inserted and removed using a specific type of plunger.

Artificial tears can be a great starting point for someone experiencing dry eye but sometimes can only give limited relief. Scleral lenses are a great option for those experiencing moderate to severe dry eye when other conventional methods have not helped. They can provide longer relief for symptoms of DES due to the saline solution bathing the cornea throughout the day. This keeps the cornea constantly hydrated and, therefore, less susceptible to changes from DES such as keratitis (inflammation of the cornea).

In addition to treating DES, these lenses are also used to correct irregular astigmatism, which can be caused by corneal diseases such as keratoconus. For these patients, sclerals can provide better visual acuities than glasses. The lenses are adjusted to the prescription using corneal mapping techniques and are fitted uniquely to the curvature of the patient's eye. Usually, the fitting process takes longer for sclerals, but only because the lens is custom-made.



EASY CHEESY **BURGER BISCUITS**



resident recipe Written by **Ellie Perler**

- 1 can flaky layers buttermilk biscuits (8 count)
- ½ pound cooked ground beef, drained and cooled
- 4 cheese slices, your choice (cut into quarters)
- ½ cup finely shredded cheese, your choice
- ¾ cup chopped pickles
- ¼ tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- ¼ tsp garlic
- 1/4 tsp crushed chili flakes

Double the ingredients to make more biscuits

Fully cook ground beef in skillet with salt, pepper, garlic, and pepper flakes. Drain well, toss in shredded cheese, and combine. Let mixture cool.

Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. Open biscuits and split each one in half using your hands. Place biscuits in rows on the baking sheet and let sit for 10 minutes. Gently pull each piece of dough to stretch it out. Be careful not to break or make holes.

Place a quarter piece of cheese slice onto each piece. Add a few pieces of pickle, 1 1/2-2 tablespoons of ground beef, and more pickle. Cup hand and press down on the mixture. Repeat.

Gently stretch other dough piece over filling side, pressing and firmly sealing around the edges of the biscuit. Pick up if needed to reshape and make sure sides are fully closed. Press the center of the biscuit gently with your hands to spread the beef inside. Space out biscuits on the baking sheet.

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Bake 15-20 minutes or until biscuits are golden brown.

To make later, cover uncooked biscuits on the baking sheet and place them in the fridge

Serve with your favorite dipping sauce, ketchup, BBQ, or mustard.



travel tales

s you drive through historical St. Augustine, you see very old structures that date back to the "not yet United States." St. Augustine was established in 1565, over 50 years before the Pilgrims had landed in Plymouth, MA. In this article, I will describe different highlights in the area: food, stores, museums, and even fountains.

Starting off with food! St. Augustine does not disappoint. The first night in St. Augustine, we went to the Forgotten Tonic. They have a range of foods, from marinated olives to fried green tomatoes to fresh fish. Each morning we ate breakfast at Avilés, the restaurant at our hotel. They had a variety of options for breakfast and dinner. For lunch, on the second day, we went to Columbia, a sister restaurant to the one in Tampa's Ybor City Historic District, for an authentic Spanish meal. I recommend the empanadas, which are beef-filled puff pastries. On the third day, we went to Catch 27 for dinner. They have delicious tacos.



Now onto stores! St. Augustine has plentiful mom-and-pop stores, lots of art galleries, and countless gift stores. Most of the galleries in the historic art district feature works made by local artists. If you are looking for a gift store in St. Augustine, you will be able to find one easily, don't worry.

Next up ... museums and historical sites! There are lots of historic sites and museums in St. Augustine, so if you go, I recommend taking the trolley for an overview. Some museums that stood out to me include America's first and oldest wax museum, Potter's Wax Museum, the Lightner Museum, and the Old Jail. Most of all, I recommend seeing Flagler College. This college used to be called the Hotel Ponce de Leon. Mr. Flagler was a very wealthy man who











built railroads and developed real estate along the east coast of Florida. He built this \$2.5 million hotel out of concrete, and it was intended for extremely wealthy people. At the time of its completion in 1888, it cost \$9,000 to stay there for the season, roughly 3-4 months during the winter. This is equivalent to around \$200,000 in today's dollars. The hotel took a mere 18 months to build. Mr. Flagler had all of the artwork, floors, columns, rooms, ceilings, chandeliers, murals, and Tiffany glass windows finished in record time with people working around the clock. Later this hotel was turned into a college. The college hosts tours throughout the day, and I would definitely recommend taking the tour!

Now, fountains. One of the primary reasons St. Augustine was established was because of a "fountain." This mythical fountain, the Fountain of Youth, supposedly circulated special magical water that could keep a person young forever. Ponce de Leon, a Spanish explorer, absolutely needed this water, perhaps at the request of Queen Isabella of Spain, so he set out on a journey to find it. Of course, he never really found it because we still hear people talking about their wrinkles and gray hair. However, Ponce de Leon did discover "La Florida" and landed at St. Augustine in 1513. The famous fountain is located in the Fountain of Youth Archeological Park. You can drink some of the water from the fountain, but it does not taste very

good, nor does it work. Thankfully, the park has many other activities, like a cannon firing demonstration, a musket firing demonstration, and a lesson from an experienced blacksmith on how to forge a nail. Oh, and did I mention you can feed peacocks! Although the peacocks will pluck peanuts right from the palm of your hand, I don't advise doing so. My mom was nipped by a peacock, who I think had food anxiety. Man, that was a crazy peacock!

St. Augustine is a wonder with lots to see and do, and I hope you visit one day!





"I was inspired by the women in Florida who wanted functionality in their clothing," says Melody. This retired principal launched the Joey Pouch Leggings in May 2021.




This summer, these two girls are looking forward to getting involved in gymnastics. Madeleine will also be attending sailing camp at St. Pete Yacht Club.






